Construction Dewatering Methods

Joe Hockberger, Senior Project Manager – Mersino Dewatering, Inc.

Large scale dewatering is a niche specialty services which is often required when excavation for construction or maintenance is required below the groundwater surface, diversion of waterways for utility installation, drawdown and water level maintenance of water bodies for construction, inspection, and to control water during flooding. Methods of dewatering including deep well dewatering, wellpoint dewatering, trenched tile collection systems and sock dewatering as well as eductor well dewatering. Large scale dewatering is equipment and energy intensive, and effective planning for dewatering can help improve project schedule and cost.

Mr. Hockberger will discuss various dewatering techniques, some unique and interesting case histories, and will discuss how engineers and contractors can preliminarily budget for dewatering.
